- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.

- ❖ Any misdemeanours and breach of this Code of Expectations will be dealt with immediately by a DUDDON CANOE CLUB official.
